## 1 REPORTS

### 1.1 Chair's Report

### 1.2 Treasurer's Report (Kim)

- Chequing Account: $\$ 6,406.48$
- Gaming Account: $\$ 3,932.02$

About $\$ 3000.00$ to come in from Hot Lunch. We've made about $\$ 1400.00$ from fundraising so far this year. DFS
made a profit of about $\$ 850.00$, but we have to pay a freight charge of $\$ 50.00$ for what we believe are the deliveries to the school. This needs to be looked into (Mr. Hurley).

- Future expenses we should be expecting are \$1500-\$2000 - > Skiing(\$800.00), Winter activities(\$200.00) and Swimming (\$500.00). This is to help parents who are unable to pay the fees for their children.
- Kootenay Savings donated the Care Wear money again this year (\$424.00). This will be designated to the Hot Lunch Program ( $\$ 367.00$-program cost) -Motioned by Cheryl Tereposky and Second by Stacey Throop.
- Past donation from K.S. Care Wear (about $\$ 200.00$ ) will accompany the leftover from this years donation and roll over to use later this year for suggestions like watermelon for the end of the year.


### 1.3 DPAC

2) Winter concert went well. Any thoughts? - Jessica Ludwar was wondering why there were saved seats at the front for some parents. Mr. Hurley explained that these were for the Hot Lunch volunteers. The concert is usually on Thursday and they wouldn't get a seat, due to clean up, if they did not seats saved. As well Mr. Hurley suggested that it was a nice offering as they volunteer their time throughout the year for the kids.
3)     - Winter Activities - Outdoor adventure, X-Country Skiing, Snowshoeing and Skating.

- Skiing - Teachers raving about the excellent work by Red mountain staff.

5) Transportation support - PAC donated over $\$ 4000.00$ last year an BK spent $\$ 9000.00$. This year the ministry has infused transportation money into the school so the school will not need to ask for financial support from the PAC for bussing anymore.
6) PAC to look at what our new focus will be as bussing will be taken care of. It was suggested that this financial support from the ministry may be just for this year so we will hold off on this until Mr. Hurley confirms the information.
7) Sports Fund : This would be advantageous to set up as it can be available to use as needed for such things as equipment that we wouldn't typically buy for the school or for teacher coverage during student sport travel. It was suggested to donate $\$ 500.00$ for the sports account. Motioned by Sydney Thiessen and Second by Cheryl Tereposky.
8) More snow discs and shovels could be used. 20 - saucers and 10 Shovels needed and would come to $\$ 201.26$. We could use the $\$ 115.00$ Canadian Tire money for this and the rest from the Gaming account. Motioned by Stacey Throop and Second by Cheryl Tereposky.
