 - * Principal's Report
- 1) Would PAC be willing to help out with money to purchase staging lights (\$2000.00)? Could possibly use some money from the gaming account. Could look at renting the lights out to eventually make some of the money back that was put into purchasing them, as we would only use them a couple times per year.
- 2) Castlegar Bowling Alley is too small. Outdoor winter activity adventure around the school will replace the bowling. Jessie Halton and Mike Hurley will be putting this together.
- Skiing Had a hard time keeping track of all the grade 5/6 children at Red Mountain last year. Had an incident where some children took the wrong run and were disorientated for awhile. Flagging tape tied to something (arm) was suggested as a means of being able to better recognize BK kids on the ski hill this year.
- 8) Report Cards Few negative comments about the new Report Cards. Some parents had concerns that the comments were not specific enough to their child. Children and their friends had identical comments on both report cards. Mr. Hurley informed everyone that each teacher writes up their student's cards differently. There are pre-written comments to choose from and some teachers use these more often than others. Mr Hurley assured everyone that just because these pre-written comments are being used doesn't mean they don't apply to the child. It may be that the comments chosen meet that child as well as others.
- 9) BK Hats Kayden wondering about BK hats (\$20) / toques (\$7) online. Would PAC be interested in helping out with this? Kayden to do more research. PAC may be willing to pay for the logo fee and then parents can purchase a T-shirt or hat at that point. Suggested that an order form could be set up with choices.
- 10) Wondering if PAC would be interested in covering TTOC charges for a teacher who takes BK children on trips (if necessary). This would probably only occur a couple times per year at a half day (approx. \$380). Rebecca Scown expressed her concern that the PAC should not be paying a teacher's wage. PAC will consider this and Mr. Hurley will look into ways the money can come from another funded area to which PAC could then possibly help out in return.
